Thank you for helping stop the spread of illness in our community!

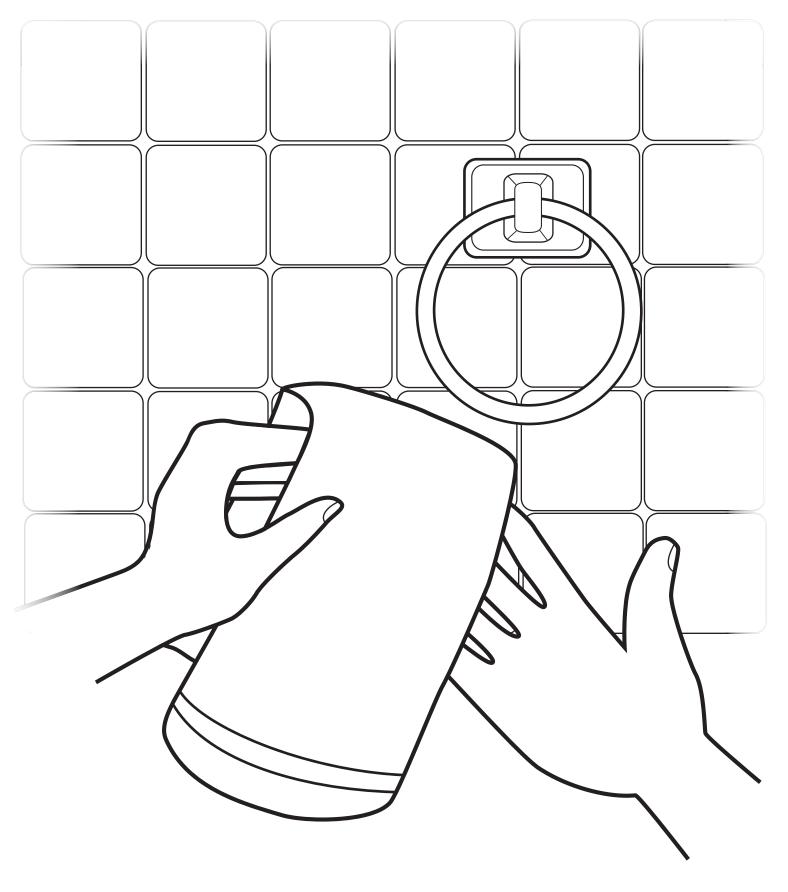

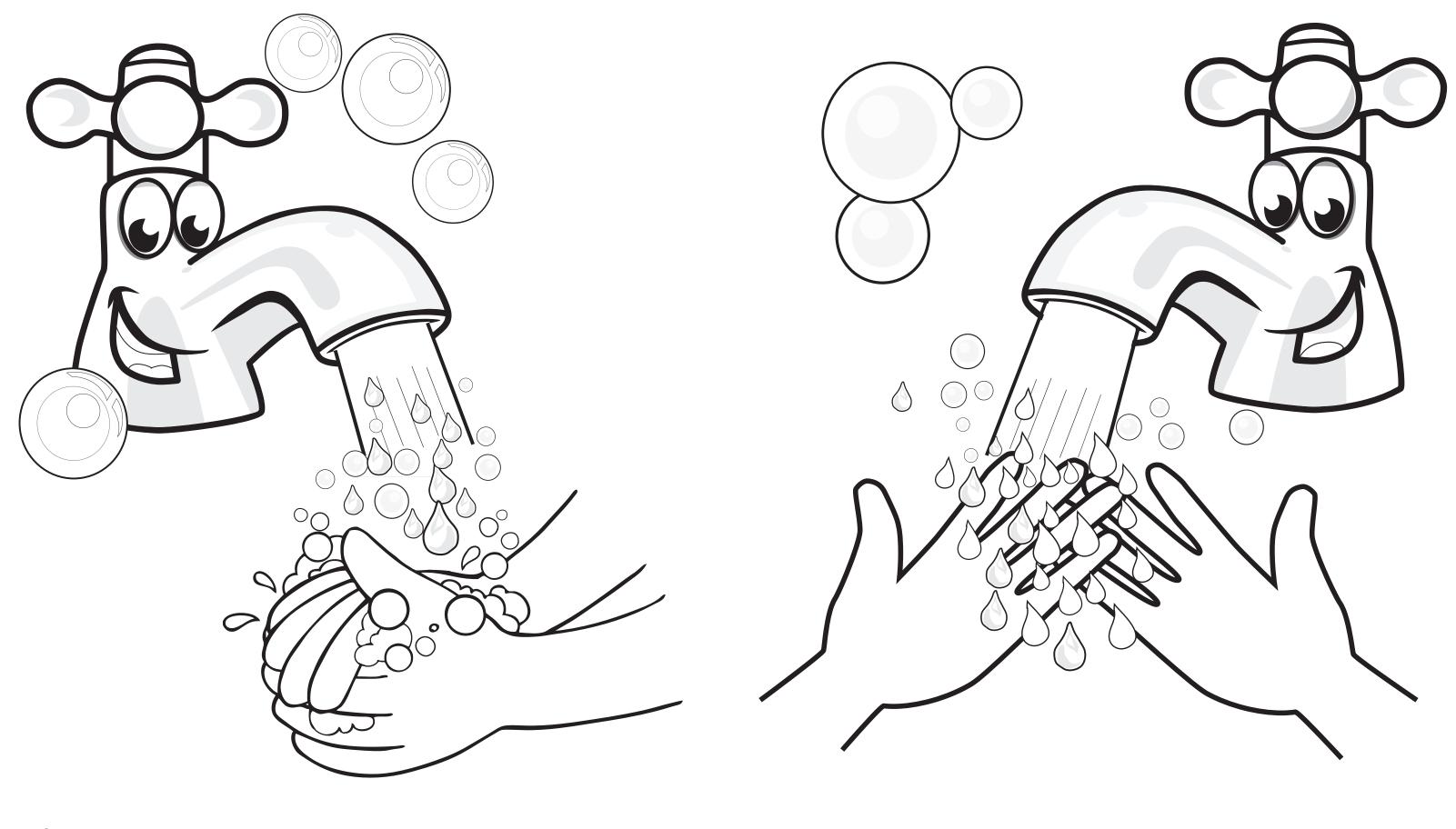








Step 5: Dry hands with clean towels

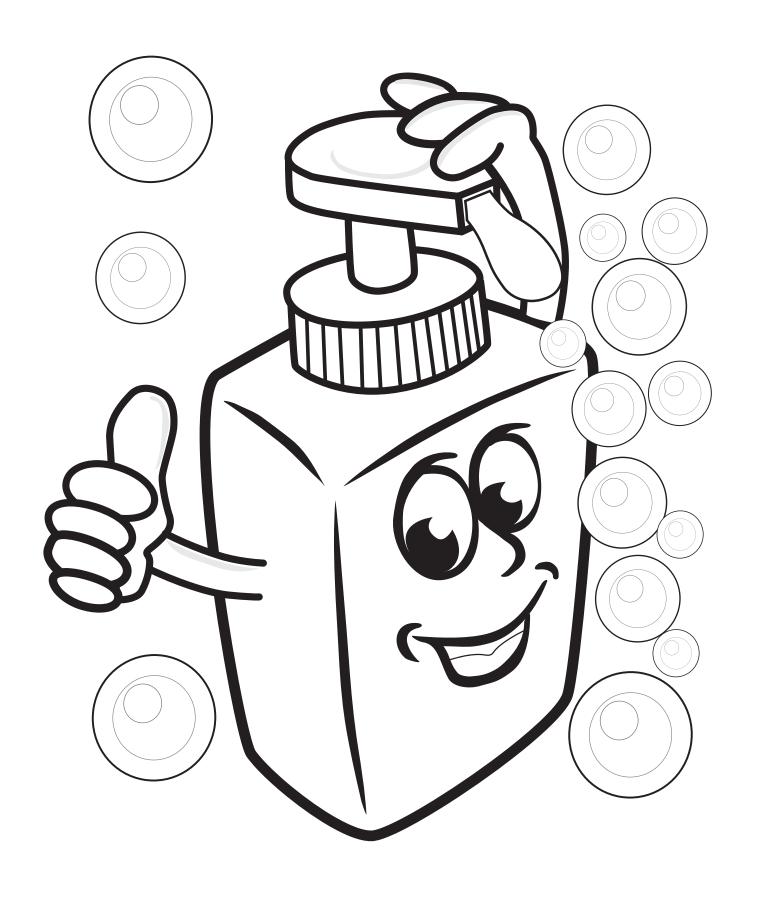




Step 4: Rinse well under warm running water
