- Notification and invitation to key stakeholders to address opioid and substance use in Huron



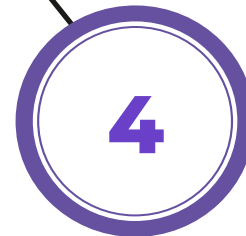
**Implementation

- Community partner collaboration – Substance Misuse Working group was created
- Naloxone – dispensing, education and availability
- Early Warning and Surveillance systems established

- Multi-sector service inventory of mental health and addiction services
- Opioid Situational Assessment conducted
- Interviews with service providers and agencies



**Analysis  
and Planning**

- 4 pillar themed recommendations from Situational Assessment
- 8 overarching tactics for a county-wide plan
- Opioid Related Emergency Plan



**Community  
Response**

- Collective action from community partners to engage community
- Outlined and ready to implement

**Formed in 2017** to implement a coordinated opioid response, the Huron County Substance Misuse Working Group is made up of many partners, including the Huron County Health Unit, OPP, first responders, hospitals, physicians, frontline mental health and addiction services, education and local community groups.
